Notes

1. AI Survey

- A campus-wide AI survey is planned for the spring to gather information on AI-related work happening across campus.

2. Student Feature Request

- Shared a link to the group for a student feature request.

3. Discoverable Sites

- Summary of discussions between ATL and TLS on ensuring the usefulness of discoverable courses while avoiding clutter.
- **Decision:** Courses can be added if universal enrollment is acceptable. Otherwise, individual sites must manage their own enrollments.

4. Server Overage

- Report on findings regarding server overages from last spring. A change plan is being developed over the summer to address the issue.

5. File Upload Limit

- Issue regarding a file upload limit of 2GB, and members noted students sporadically encountering similar limits.

6. Integrity Advocate

- No current solution for secure online proctoring.
- IA has delayed due to several reasons, with TLS planning to re-engage.

7. Course Merchant/Engage

- The implementation is underway, targeting a mid-December launch.

8. LTI Migrations

- Migration processes are ongoing for available vendors.
